The Committee on Transportation (Clary) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete everything after the enacting clause

and insert:

Section 1. This act may be cited as the "Justin McWilliams 'Justice For Justin' Act."

Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 316.027, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

316.027 Crash involving death or personal injuries.--

(1)(a) The driver of any vehicle involved in a crash occurring on public or private property that results ~~resulting~~ in injury of any person must immediately stop the vehicle at the scene of the crash, or as close thereto as possible, and must remain at the scene of the crash until he or she has fulfilled the requirements of s. 316.062. Any person who willfully violates this paragraph is guilty of a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.

1 (b) The driver of any vehicle involved in a crash
 2 occurring on public or private property that results ~~resulting~~
 3 in the death of any person must immediately stop the vehicle
 4 at the scene of the crash, or as close thereto as possible,
 5 and must remain at the scene of the crash until he or she has
 6 fulfilled the requirements of s. 316.062. Any person who
 7 willfully violates this paragraph is guilty of a felony of the
 8 first ~~second~~ degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s.
 9 775.083, or s. 775.084.

10 Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 2005.
