19	municipal functions; that it is their duty to protect life and									
20	property at their own risk and peril; that it is their duty to									
21	continuously instruct school personnel, public officials, and									
22	private citizens about safety; and that their activities are									
23	vital to the public safety. Therefore, the Legislature declares									
24	that it is a proper and legitimate state purpose to provide a									
25	uniform retirement system for the benefit of firefighters,									
26	emergency medical technicians, paramedics, law enforcement									
27	officers, correctional officers, and correctional probation
