(8) CONTRACTOR PROHIBITIONS.-

(a) A contractor, as defined in chapter 287, Florida Statutes, or its employees, agents, or subcontractors, may not directly or indirectly supervise, direct, or act as an approving authority over any state employee or the actions committed to the responsibility of state employees.

(b) A contractor, as defined in chapter 287, Florida Statutes, or its employees, agents, or subcontractors, may not knowingly participate through decision, approval, disapproval, recommendation, preparation of any part of a purchase request, influencing the content of any specification or procurement standard, rendering of advice, investigation, or auditing, or in any other advisory capacity, in the procurement of contractual services from an entity of which the contractor,
