Senate Amendment

On page 4, line 16, delete that line

and insert: decisions of each agency. The project management requirements for agencies may vary based on the size and nature of their information technology projects. Projects that refresh desktop units or infrastructure equipment with new technology that is similar to the technology currently in use are exempt from the project planning and reporting requirements in this section unless otherwise specified in the General Appropriations Act.

1. For projects with a total cost ranging from \$500,000 to \$1,999,999, agencies must appoint a dedicated project manager to implement the agency's project management methodology and ensure needed project planning and management requirements are fulfilled.

2. For projects with a total cost ranging from \$500,000 to \$10 million that involve routine hardware and/or

1 software upgrades for a single agency, the agency must appoint
2 a project manager to implement the agency's project management
3 methodology and ensure needed project planning and management
4 requirements are fulfilled.

5 3. For projects with a total cost ranging from \$2
6 million to \$10 million that will impact the general public or
7 that can change or affect an agency's organizational
8 structure, headcount, business processes, or service delivery
9 model, the agency must appoint a dedicated project manager and
10 project management team, and must ensure that all project
11 management provisions of this section are implemented.

12 4. For any project with a total cost greater than \$10
13 million, the agency must appoint a dedicated project manager
14 and project management team, and must ensure that all project
15 management provisions of this section are implemented.
