A bill to be entitled

An act relating to outdoor advertising; creating s. 479.157, F.S.; authorizing the repair or reconstruction of any lawful nonconforming sign damaged or destroyed by a major or catastrophic disaster, notwithstanding any statute, ordinance, rule, or regulation to the contrary, provided that the repair or reconstruction is in compliance with the Florida Building Code; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 479.157, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

479.157 Repair or reconstruction of nonconforming signs damaged or destroyed by major or catastrophic disaster.--Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 479.155 or any other statute, ordinance, rule, or regulation to the contrary, the owner or lessee of any lawful nonconforming sign damaged or destroyed by a major or catastrophic disaster, as defined in s.

252.34(1), may repair or reconstruct such lawful nonconforming sign, provided that the repair or reconstruction is in

compliance with the construction standards set forth in the

Section 2. This act shall take upon becoming a law.
