recommended the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 1, lines 15-26, delete those lines

and insert:

Section 1. The Department of Environmental Protection shall design a pilot project, for implementation in 2006, to encourage the reuse or recycling of campaign signs. At a minimum, the department shall identify two large counties and two small counties to establish a central depository for used campaign signs and to make such signs available, at no cost to the receiving entity, to schools and other entities that may have a use for them and to companies that can recycle the materials from which the signs are made into new materials or products. As part of this pilot project, the department shall submit details for the program along with a budget request, for use of funds from the Solid Waste Management Trust Fund prior to the start of the 2006 Regular Session.
