6 for Health Care Administration, in consultation with the  
7 Department of Children and Family Services, may establish a  
8 targeted case-management project in those counties identified by  
9 the Department of Children and Family Services and for all  
10 counties with a community-based child welfare project, as  
11 authorized under s. 409.1671, which have been specifically  
12 approved by the department. Results of targeted case management  
13 projects shall be reported to the Social Services Estimating  
14 Conference established under s. 216.136. The covered group of

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16 include children who are eligible for Medicaid; who are between  
 17 the ages of birth through 21; and who are under protective  
 18 supervision or postplacement supervision, under foster-care  
 19 supervision, or in shelter care or foster care, or young adults  
 20 who have reached 18 years of age but are not yet 22 years of age  
 21 and who were in foster care when they turned 18 years of age, as  
 22 described in s. 409.1451. The number of individuals who are  
 23 eligible to receive targeted case management shall be limited to  
 24 the number for whom the Department of Children and Family  
 25 Services has available matching funds to cover the costs. The  
 26 general revenue funds required to match the funds for services  
 27 provided by the community-based child welfare projects are  
 28 limited to funds available for services described under s.  
 29 409.1671. Additional funding for this service may be made  
 30 available through certification of match by any local or state  
 31 public tax revenue source. The number of individuals who are  
 32 eligible to receive targeted case management shall be limited to  
 33 the number for whom certified local or state public tax revenue  
 34 sources are available to cover the cost. The Department of  
 35 Children and Family Services may transfer the general revenue  
 36 matching funds as billed by the Agency for Health Care  
 37 Administration.
