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16 include children who are eligible for Medicaid; who are between 17 the ages of birth through 21; and who are under protective supervision or postplacement supervision, under foster-care 18 supervision, or in shelter care or foster care, or young adults 19 who have reached 18 years of age but are not yet 22 years of age 20 21 and who were in foster care when they turned 18 years of age, as 22 described in s. 409.1451. The number of individuals who are eligible to receive targeted case management shall be limited to 23 24 the number for whom the Department of Children and Family Services has available matching funds to cover the costs. The 25 26 general revenue funds required to match the funds for services 27 provided by the community-based child welfare projects are 28 limited to funds available for services described under s. 409.1671. Additional funding for this service may be made 29 30 available through certification of match by any local or state 31 public tax revenue source. The number of individuals who are 32 eligible to receive targeted case management shall be limited to 33 the number for whom certified local or state public tax revenue 34 sources are available to cover the cost.
