House Joint Resolution

A joint resolution proposing the repeal of Section 9 of Article IV and Section 23 of Article XII of the State Constitution, relating to the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

That the repeal of Section 9 of Article IV and Section 23 of Article XII of the State Constitution is agreed to and shall be submitted to the electors of Florida for approval or rejection at the general election to be held in November 2006.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the title and substance of the repeal proposed herein shall appear on the ballot as follows:

ELIMINATION OF CONSTITUTIONAL AUTHORITY OF FISH AND WILDLIFE CONSERVATION COMMISSION; REGULATION PURSUANT TO LAW

Proposes the repeal of Section 9 of Article IV and Section 23 of Article XII of the State Constitution to eliminate the constitutional authority of the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, which would leave the regulation of wild animal life, fresh water aquatic life, and marine life that was provided under such authority to be determined by the Legislature by law.
