3 s. 290.00710, F.S.; authorizing the City of
4 Lakeland to apply to the Office of Tourism,
5 Trade, and Economic Development for designation
6 of an enterprise zone; providing requirements;
7 requiring the office to establish an effective
8 date for the designated enterprise zone;
9 creating s. 290.0073, F.S.; authorizing Indian
10 River County, the City of Vero Beach, and the
11 City of Sebastian to jointly apply to the
12 Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic
13 Development for designation of an enterprise
14 zone in Indian River County; providing
15 requirements with respect thereto; requiring
16 the office to establish the initial effective
17 date of the enterprise zone; providing an
18 effective date.

20 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
21

22 Section 1. Section 290.00710, Florida Statutes, is
23 created to read:

24 290.00710 Enterprise zone designation for the City of
25 Lakeland.--The City of Lakeland may apply to the Office of
26 Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development for designation of
27 one enterprise zone for an area within the City of Lakeland,
28 which zone shall encompass an area up to 10 square miles. The
29 application must be submitted by December 31, 2005, and must
30 comply with the requirements of s. 290.0055. Notwithstanding
31 s. 290.0065, limiting the total number of enterprise zones

1 designated and the number of enterprise zones within a
2 population category, the Office of Tourism, Trade, and
3 Economic Development may designate one enterprise zone under
4 this section. The Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic
5 Development shall establish the initial effective date of the
6 enterprise zone designated pursuant to this section.

7 Section 2. Section 290.0073, Florida Statutes, is
8 created to read:

9 290.0073 Enterprise zone designation for Indian River
10 County, the City of Vero Beach, and the City of
11 Sebastian.--Indian River County, the City of Vero Beach, and
12 the City of Sebastian may jointly apply to the Office of
13 Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development for designation of
14 one enterprise zone encompassing an area not to exceed 10
15 square miles. The application must be submitted by December
16 31, 2005, and must comply with the requirements of s.
17 290.0055. Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 290.0065
18 limiting the total number of enterprise zones designated and
19 the number of enterprise zones within a population category,
20 the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development may
21 designate one enterprise zone under this section. The Office
22 of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development shall establish
23 the initial effective date of the enterprise zone designated
24 pursuant to this section.

25 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
