- Section 1. <u>Program to provide discounted computers to low-</u>income students.--
- (1) There is created a program to provide qualifying low-income students with computers at a discounted price.
- (2) A student who attends a public school in this state, who is in a grade level from grade 5 through grade 12, and who is currently on the free lunch program is eligible to receive a computer at a discounted price.
- (3) The Department of Education shall negotiate with a computer manufacturer concerning:
- (a) The price of a discounted computer and whether computer accessories such as a printer or scanner will be offered to the students at reduced prices.
- (b) A specialized software package, including, but not limited to:
  - 1. A word processor;

- 3. An operating system.
- (c) The type of warranty that is to be provided to the students and whether an extended warranty will be available to the students and under what terms.
- (4) The Department of Education shall adopt rules concerning:
- (a) How to integrate into this program the provision of computer or technical training to students in their respective school districts.
- (b) The distribution of eligibility-verification certificates to the students, the locations at which discounted computers are available, and how to obtain and pay for the equipment covered by this program.
  - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
