A bill to be entitled

An act relating to life insurance for Florida National Guard members; providing for issuing a life insurance policy to members of the Florida National Guard under certain circumstances; specifying an amount; requiring the Legislature to provide for a continuing appropriation to pay the premiums on such policies under certain circumstances; providing for repeal if the policies and premiums are provided by the Federal Government; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Each member of the Florida National Guard who is called to active duty in the service of the United States shall be issued a life insurance policy in the amount of \$250,000. The Legislature shall provide for a continuing appropriation from the General Revenue Fund to pay the premiums on such policy during the period of active duty for such member. This provision is repealed whenever similar life insurance is provided by the Federal Government.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
