11 SENATE SUMMARY

12 Revises the elements of the offense of voyeurism in order
13 to eliminate acts of photographing, filming, videotaping,
14 or recording, which are made a crime under the offense of
15 video voyeurism. Provides that a person commits the
16 offense of voyeurism when he or she secretly observes
17 another person when the other person is in a location
18 that provides a reasonable expectation of privacy.
