A bill to be entitled

An act relating to highway signs; requiring the Department of Transportation to erect directional signs to certain colleges and universities in this state; requiring such colleges or universities to pay for the construction, erection, and maintenance of such signs; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) The Department of Transportation shall install highway directional guide signs at specified highway exits at the request of any college or university that has a campus in this state which:

(a) Offers at a minimum, baccalaureate degree and graduate degree programs; and

(b) Has at least 350 students enrolled at the campus where the signs are to be located.

(2) The respective college or university must pay all costs related to the construction, erection, and maintenance of such signs.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.

SENATE SUMMARY

Requires the Department of Transportation to erect signs for certain colleges and universities. Requires the institutions to pay for construction, erection, and maintenance of the signs.
