A bill to be entitled

An act relating to child support; amending s.
409.2558, F.S.; requiring the Department of
Revenue to establish by rule a method that uses
reasonable efforts to locate persons to whom
collections or refunds are owed, including
disclosing information on the Internet;
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section
409.2558, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

409.2558 Support distribution and disbursement.--

(2) ~~UNDISTRIBUTABLE COLLECTIONS.--~~

(a) The department shall establish by rule the method
for determining a collection or refund to a noncustodial
parent to be undistributable to the final intended recipient.
This method must provide for reasonable efforts to locate and
notify persons to whom collections or refunds are owed,
including disclosure on the Internet of the names of obligees
and obligors and the account number assigned by the
depository, as defined in s. 61.046.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.

SENATE SUMMARY

Requires the Department of Revenue to adopt rules for
using reasonable efforts to locate persons to whom
collections or refunds are owed, including disclosing
information on the Internet.
