Pursuant to section 189.429, Florida Statutes, 12 this act constitutes the codification of all special acts 13 14 relating to the Avalon Beach-Mulat Fire Protection District. It 15 is the intent of the Legislature in enacting this law to provide 16 a single, comprehensive special act charter for the district, 17 including all current legislative authority granted to the 18 district by its several legislative enactments and any 19 additional authority granted by this act. 20 Section 2. Chapters 80-608, 82-378, 82-379, and 91-392, 21 Laws of Florida, are codified, reenacted, amended, and repealed as provided in this act. 22 The charter for the Avalon Beach-Mulat Fire 23 Section 3. 24 Protection District is re-created and reenacted to read: 25 Section 1. Definitions. -- As used in this act unless 26 otherwise specified: (1) "District" means the Avalon Beach-Mulat Fire 27 28 Protection District.

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(2) "Board" and "board of commissioners" mean the board of 29 30 commissioners of and for the district. 31 "Commissioner" means a member of the board of (3) 32 commissioners of and for the district. 33 "County" means Santa Rosa County. (4) 34 "Residence" means one single-family dwelling such as (5) one single-apartment dwelling unit, one single-condominium 35 dwelling unit, one single-duplex dwelling unit, one single-36 family dwelling unit, one single-mobile home dwelling unit. 37 "Single-mobile home dwelling unit" means the realty upon which a 38 39 residential mobile home is located, whether a rental space or lot, or otherwise, but does not refer to the mobile home itself. 40 41 "Business" means motels or apartments subject to sales (6) 42 tax along with other standard commercial businesses such as 43 gasoline stations, stores, marinas, and similar establishments. 44 Section 2. (1) District created.--There is hereby created a special taxing fire protection and rescue service district 45 46 incorporating lands in Santa Rosa County described in subsection 47 (2) which shall be a public corporation having the powers, duties, obligations, and immunities herein set forth, under the 48 49 name of the Avalon Beach-Mulat Fire Protection District and also 50 known as the Avalon Fire/Rescue District with all the powers and duties specified in chapter 191, Florida Statutes, including 51 52 non-ad valorem and ad valorem assessments. 185	(1) The board shall make an annual report of its actions
186	and accounting of its funds and shall file said report in
187	accordance with Article VII of the State Constitution, and
188	chapters 191, 192, and 218, Florida Statutes.
189	(2) The board shall file and publish its annual budget
190	showing estimated revenue and estimated expenditures incurred by
191	the district in carrying out its operations pursuant to Article
192	VII of the State Constitution, and chapters 191, 192, and 218,
193	Florida Statutes.
194	Section 5. SeverabilityIf any clause, section, or
195	provision of this act shall be declared to be unconstitutional
196	or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the same
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197	shall be eliminated from this act, and the remaining portion of
198	said act shall be in force and effect and be as valid as if such
199	invalid portion thereof had not been incorporated therein,
200	provided the same may be so separated.
201	Section 4. <u>Chapters 80-608, 82-378, 82-379, and 91-392,</u>
202	Laws of Florida, are repealed.
203	Section 5. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
