Section 2. Section 322.073, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

322.073 Licensing of foreign nationals who visit this state.--

(1) The Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles
may, subject to the requirements of this section, issue a driver
license to an applicant who is a foreign national and who
legally visits this state on a frequent basis for business or
pleasure but who has not immigrated to the United States.

- years following the date on which it is issued or, if a nonimmigrant visa is required for entry into the United States by a driver license applicant, a license issued under this section is valid for the duration of the nonimmigrant visa issued to the applicant by the United States Government, up to a maximum of 6 years. If the nonimmigrant visa driver license applicant is holding a nonimmigrant visa with less than 6 years' validity remaining on the nonimmigrant visa, then a license issued under this section is valid for the duration remaining on the nonimmigrant visa issued to the applicant by the United States Government and may be renewed thereafter under the same restriction and conditions as the initial issuance if the applicant, at the time of renewal, satisfies the requirements of this section.
- (3) When an applicant for a driver license is from a visa-waiver country that has been identified as such by the Department of Homeland Security, the applicant shall, upon meeting all eligibility requirements, be issued a license or an identification card, or both, for a period of up to 6 years.

 Such a license or identification card may be renewed thereafter under the same restrictions and conditions as those applying to the initial issuance if the applicant, at the time of renewal, satisfies the requirements of this section.
- (4) To receive or renew a driver license under this section, a legal nonimmigrant visitor applicant must submit to the department all of the following:

- (b) For an applicant entering from a country that is not identified by the United States Office of Citizenship and Immigration Services as a visa-waiver country, a valid nonimmigrant visa issued to the applicant by the United States Government.
- (c) A valid and current I-94 form issued by the United States Office of Citizenship and Immigration Services to the applicant.
- (d) A valid driver license from the home country of the applicant.
- (5) Each such applicant must provide, in addition to the items specified in paragraphs (4)(a)-(d), evidence satisfactory to the department which shows:
- (a) Proof of ownership of or a leasehold interest in a motor vehicle; or
- (b)1. The necessity for the applicant to operate a motor vehicle; and
- 2. Proof that, for a period of at least 6 months during the previous 5 years, the applicant has had:
 - a. An established presence in this state; or
- b. Ownership of or a lease on a residential property in this state.
- (6) A driver license issued under this section is property of the state. A person in possession of a driver license must provide it to a law enforcement officer upon request. A law enforcement officer having a reasonable belief that a person

- possesses or is using a driver license in violation of this section or any other law may seize the driver license. A person from whom a law enforcement officer seizes a driver license under this section does not have a cause of action against the law enforcement officer for the seizure of the driver license. The department may cancel a driver license issued under this section upon determining that the foreign national is no longer entitled to the issuance of the driver license.
- (7) The department shall establish fees for the initial issuance and renewal of a driver license under this section.
- Section 3. Paragraph (c) is added to subsection (1) of section 322.14, Florida Statutes, to read:
 - 322.14 Licenses issued to drivers.--

(c) In addition to the requirements of paragraph (a), each driver's license issued to a foreign national must clearly indicate that the license is valid for driving purposes only by exhibiting in bold font and red letters: "FOR DRIVING PURPOSES ONLY."
