Section 401.2915, Florida Statutes, is 18 amended to read: 19 401.2915 Automated external defibrillators.--It is the 20 21 intent of the Legislature that an automated external 22 defibrillator may be used by any person for the purpose of 23 saving the life of another person in cardiac arrest. In order to ensure public health and safety: 2.4 (1) All persons who use an automated external 25 defibrillator must obtain appropriate training, to include 26 27 completion of a course in cardiopulmonary resuscitation or 2.8 successful completion of a basic first aid course that includes cardiopulmonary resuscitation training, and 29 demonstrated proficiency in the use of an automated external 30 defibrillator<u>.</u>+ 31
