6 (3) A school or school district personnel shall not  
7 make a referral for diagnosis or treatment of any student for

9 of Mental Disorders. However, this subsection does not  
10 prohibit a teacher or the school district personnel from  
11 sharing classroom-based observations with parents regarding a  
12 student's academic and functional performance and behavior in  
13 the classroom or school.

20 The committee substitute makes the following changes:

- 21 -Deletes the requirements related to dispensing  
22 psychotropic medication by licensed health care  
23 professionals.  
24 -Requires psychotropic medication to be administered  
25 pursuant to s.1006.062,F.S.  
26 -Prohibits school or school district personnel from  
27 making referrals for the diagnosis or treatment of a  
28 student for any disorder listed in the Diagnostic and  
29 Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders.  
30 -Allows teachers or school district personnel to share  
31 classroom-based observations with parents about students'  
classroom behavior and academic and functional  
performance.
