A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the Florida Litter Law;
amending s. 403.413, F.S.; increasing the fine
for a noncriminal infraction of the Florida
Litter Law from \$50 to \$200; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (6) of section
403.413, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

403.413 Florida Litter Law.--

(6) PENALTIES; ENFORCEMENT.--

(a) Any person who dumps litter in violation of
subsection (4) in an amount not exceeding 15 pounds in weight
or 27 cubic feet in volume and not for commercial purposes is
guilty of a noncriminal infraction, punishable by a civil
penalty of ~~\$200~~\$50. In addition, the court may require the
violation to pick up litter or perform other labor commensurate
with the offense committed.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
