A bill to be entitled

An act relating to law enforcement; creating s.
943.1713, F.S.; requiring the Criminal Justice
Standards and Training Commission to establish
annual firearms qualification instruction
standards for law enforcement officers;
requiring agencies to report qualification
results; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 943.1713, Florida Statutes, is
created to read:

943.1713 Basic skills training in handling firearms
for annual qualification.--

(1) The commission shall establish standards for
instruction of law enforcement officers in the subject of
firearms qualification. Each basic skills course that is
required for law enforcement officers to obtain initial
certification shall, after January 1, 2006, include a minimum
of 8 hours of training in handling firearms for annual
qualification. Such training must include training in handgun
and shotgun proficiency.

(2) State agencies, including county and municipal law
enforcement agencies must report qualification results
pursuant to a schedule adopted by commission rule.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
