Each permitholder referred to in subsection (1) shall 18 (2) annually, during the period commencing December 15 of each year 19 and ending January 4 of the following year, file in writing with 20 the division its application to conduct one or more thoroughbred 21 22 racing meetings during the thoroughbred racing season commencing on the following June 1. Each application shall specify the 23 24 number and dates of all performances that the permitholder 25 intends to conduct during that thoroughbred racing season. On or 26 before February 15 of each year, the division shall issue a 27 license authorizing each permitholder to conduct performances on the dates specified in its application. Up to March 31 of each 28 29 year, each permitholder may request and shall be granted changes in its authorized performances; but thereafter, as a condition 30 precedent to the validity of its license and its right to retain 31 its permit, each permitholder must operate the full number of 32 33 days authorized on each of the dates set forth in its license.
