An act relating to Holmes County; amending chapter 30843, Laws of Florida (1955), as amended, relating to the Holmes County Hospital Corporation; revising provisions relating to the corporation's issuance of bonds to construct and erect a new hospital facility in Holmes County; repealing various provisions of said chapter; requiring a referendum; providing an effective date.

10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

12 Section 1. Section 1 of chapter 30843, Laws of Florida13 (1955), as amended, is amended to read:

14 Section 1. There is hereby created a public non-profit corporation which is hereby designated the Holmes County 15 Hospital Corporation, for the purpose of establishing, acquiring 16 or constructing, erecting, equipping, maintaining and operating 17 at Bonifay, in Holmes County a public hospital primarily for the 18 benefit of the citizens and residents of Holmes County, Florida, 19 which hospital shall be known as Holmes County Hospital; and 20 21 authority is hereby given for said corporation to establish, 22 acquire or construct, erect, equip, maintain and operate a 23 public hospital at Bonifay, in Holmes County, Florida, to be known as Holmes County Hospital, such hospital to provide as 24 many beds as practicable and said corporation is further 25 authorized from time to time, when practicable, to extend, 26 27 enlarge and otherwise increase the size of said hospital and the 28 services to be rendered to the public by said hospital. Subsection (i) of section 3 of chapter 30843, Laws of Florida (1955), as amended, is amended to read: 30 Section 3. 31 32 (i) The board of trustees shall make and adopt such bylaws and rules and regulations for their own guidance and for 33 the government of the hospital as may be deemed expedient for 34 the economic and equitable conduct thereof, not inconsistent 35 with this law or the city ordinances of Bonifay, Florida, 36 wherein such hospital is located. They shall have exclusive 37 control of the expenditures of all moneys collected to the 38 39 credit of the hospital fund. Section 3. Section 12 of chapter 30843, Laws of Florida 40 (1955), as amended, is amended to read: 41 42 Section 12. Immediately upon this act becoming a law and the trustees of said Holmes County Hospital Corporation are 43 appointed and duly qualified, the said corporation shall be 44 authorized to transact business and enter into contract looking 45 to the establishment of the hospital herein provided for, to 46 incur liabilities; borrow money at such rates of interest as the 47 trustees may determine; issue its notes, bonds, or other 48 49 obligations; and secure any of its obligations by mortgage, 50 pledge, or assignment of all or any of its properties, 51 franchises, or income and may, without rendering the corporation liable beyond the sources of money pledged, borrow money giving 52 security therefor the bonds provided for herein. 53 Section 15 of chapter 30843, Laws of Florida 54 Section 4. 55 (1955), as amended, is amended to read.

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56	Section 15. (1) The trustees of Holmes County Hospital
57	Corporation are authorized to issue bonds or to have bonds
58	issued payable from legally available revenues, pledge therefore
59	property sufficient to pay the principal and interest as the
60	same become due on such bonds, which shall be in such form and
61	denomination bearing an interest rate that does not exceed that
62	authorized by general law. The form of such bonds shall be fixed
63	by resolution of the board of trustees of Holmes County Hospital
64	Corporation or the issuer and the bonds shall be signed by the
65	chair of the board countersigned by the secretary of the board
66	under the seal of the board of trustees of Holmes County
67	Hospital Corporation or as authorized by the issuer. Coupons, or
68	such legal requirements as to the issuer of bonds requires if
69	any, shall be executed by the facsimile signature of said
70	officers or the issuers. The delivery, at any subsequent date of
71	any bond and coupon so executed shall be valid, although before
72	the date of delivery, the person signing such bonds or coupons
73	shall cease to hold office or is authorized by the issuer.
74	(2) The bonds may be issued in the form and manner as
75	determined by the board of trustees of Holmes County Hospital
76	Corporation, not inconsistent with general law or the issuer,
77	which is consistent with general law. This act shall be
78	construed to provide complete authority to issue debt in any
79	reasonable form and manner as determined by the board of
80	trustees of Holmes County Hospital Corporation that are not
81	inconsistent with general law.
82	(3) No resolution or proceeding in respect to the issuance
83	of bonds hereunder shall be necessary. The bonds authorized
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84	herein shall in no event exceed on hundred seventy-five thousand
85	dollars (\$175,000.00) for the construction of the Holmes county
86	hospital authorized herein and all proceeds from such bond sale
87	remaining in the hands of the Holmes county hospital corporation
88	after payment of all costs of construction of the hospital as
89	herein authorized shall be used by said corporation for
90	equipping, operating and maintaining such county hospital in
91	connection with the hospital program outlined herein.
92	Section 5. Section 18 of chapter 30843, Laws of Florida
93	(1955), as amended, is amended to read:
94	Section 18. The board shall have the power of eminent
95	domain and may thereby condemn and acquire any real or personal
96	property within the city limits of Bonifay, Florida, which the
97	board may deem necessary for the use of said hospital
98	corporation such power of condemnation shall be exercised in the
99	same manner as is now provided by the general law for the
100	exercise of the power of eminent domain by cities and towns of
101	the state of Florida.
102	Section 6. <u>Sections 16, 17, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 26, and 27</u>
103	of chapter 30843, Laws of Florida (1955), as amended, are
104	repealed.
105	Section 7. On or before December 30, 2006, the Holmes
106	County Hospital Corporation shall call and the Supervisor of

109	referendum of the qualified voters of Holmes County on the
110	question of whether the Holmes County Hospital Corporation shall

114 Section 8. This act shall take effect only if a majority 115 of those qualified electors of Holmes County voting in the 116 referendum held pursuant to this act approve the referendum 117 question in accordance with section 7, except that this section 118 and section 7 of this act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
