Section 944.091, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 14 944.091 United States prisoners: board authorized.--15 (1) The department is authorized upon request to board 16 17 prisoners of the United States committed to their custody by any agency of the United States if such prisoners have less 18 than 6 months remaining of their federal sentence, and if such 19 prisoners have family relationships or job opportunities in 20 21 this state, on a space-available basis only. Daily 22 compensation for the board of such prisoners shall be paid at 23 a rate to be mutually agreed upon by the department and the appropriate United States agency. Such compensation is to 2.4 recover the total maintenance cost of such prisoners which 25 shall be not less than the average cost per inmate per day for 26 27 all inmates confined by the department. 28 (2) The department, when proper and adequate facilities and personnel are available, may contract with 29 proper officials of the United States to provide custody, 30 care, subsistence, education, treatment, and training for

3	(a) Any such contract must provide:
4	1. For reimbursing this state in full for all costs or
5	expenses involved;
6	2. For the state to receive persons convicted of

10	negotiated in the contract; or
11	3. For the United States to compensate this state by
12	monetary payment or receipt of persons convicted of criminal

16	(b) Such a contract may not provide for this state to
17	receive more United States prisoners than are transferred to

********** SENATE SUMMARY Authorizes the Department of Corrections to contract with the Federal Government to accept custody of persons convicted in federal court in this state. Such contract may provide for direct compensation, for an exchange of state prisoners for federal prisoners, or for a combination, but the state may not be required to accept more prisoners than does the United States Government in return. A person accepted into state custody is subject to state law and rule unless the contract provides otherwise.
