A bill to be entitled

An act relating to pharmaceutical purchasing practices; requiring the Agency for Health Care Administration and the Department of Management Services to conduct studies related to pharmaceutical purchasing practices; providing purpose; requiring a report to the Legislature; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Pharmaceutical purchasing practices.--

(1) The Agency for Health Care Administration shall conduct a study to determine the cost savings associated with the importation of pharmaceuticals for Medicaid recipients in the state.

(2) The Department of Management Services shall conduct a study to determine the cost savings associated with the importation of pharmaceuticals for members of the state group health insurance plan or their covered dependents, or to subscribers or covered dependents of a health maintenance organization plan under the state group insurance program.

(3) The purpose of the studies required under subsections (1) and (2) is to identify more fiscally responsible pharmaceutical purchasing practices for state-funded prescription plans.

(4) The Agency for Health Care Administration and the Department of Management Services shall each report the results of their respective studies to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by August 26, 2005.
