All public facilities shall 17 be consistent with the capital improvements element. Amendments 18 19 to implement this section must be adopted and transmitted no later than December 1, 2007. Thereafter, a local government may 20 not amend its future land use map, except for plan amendments to 21 22 meet new requirements under this part and emergency amendments 23 pursuant to s. 163.3187(1)(a), after December 1, 2007, and every 24 year thereafter until the local government has adopted the 25 annual update and the annual update has been transmitted to the
