Senate Joint Resolution No. 2 A joint resolution proposing the creation of a 3 new section in Article X of the State 4 Constitution relating to the Florida Hurricane 5 Catastrophe Fund. 6 7 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 8 That the following creation of a new section in Article 9 X of the State Constitution is agreed to and shall be 10 submitted to the electors of this state for approval or 11 rejection at the next general election or at an earlier 13 special election specifically authorized by law for that 14 purpose: 15 ARTICLE X MISCELLANEOUS 16 17 Assets of the Florida Hurricane Catastrophe Fund. -- The assets of the Florida Hurricane Catastrophe Fund, established 18 by general law, shall be used exclusively for paying 19 catastrophic hurricane loss obligations arising out of 20 21 reimbursement contracts with insurers, paying debt service on 22 revenue bonds and financing arrangements issued by or on 23 behalf of the fund, reinsurance costs of the fund, administrative expenses of the fund, and an annual 2.4 appropriation for hurricane loss mitigation programs. Ten 25 million dollars must be appropriated annually in the General 26 27 Appropriations Act for hurricane loss mitigation programs and 2.8 any additional appropriation from the fund for the programs must be approved by a vote of three-fourths of the membership 29 of each house of the legislature in a separate bill or bills 30 for that purpose only, provided the aggregate of any

appropriations from the fund for hurricane loss mitigation programs in a fiscal year may not exceed the greater of \$10 million dollars or an amount equal to thirty-five percent of the fund's investment income from the fiscal year that ended two years before the effective date of the appropriations. This section does not limit the authority of the legislature to abolish or otherwise terminate the operations of the Florida Hurricane Catastrophe Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be placed on the ballot:

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

ARTICLE X

amendment to the State Constitution to limit the purposes for which the Florida Hurricane Catastrophe Fund's assets may be used, require an annual \$10 million appropriation in the General Appropriations Act for hurricane loss mitigation programs, to require any additional appropriation from the fund for the programs to be subject to a three-fourths vote of the membership of the Legislature in a separate bill or bills, and to limit the aggregate of any appropriations from the fund for hurricane loss mitigation programs in a fiscal year to the greater of \$10 million or 35 percent of the fund's investment income from the fiscal year that ended 2 years before the aggregate appropriation.
