22	(1) The <u>Ronald Reagan</u> Johnnie B. Byrd, Sr.,
23	Alzheimer's Center and Research Institute is established at
24	the University of South Florida.
25	(2)(a) The State Board of Education shall enter into
26	an agreement for the utilization of the facilities on the
27	campus of the University of South Florida to be known as the
28	Ronald Reagan Johnnie B. Byrd, Sr., Alzheimer's Center and
29	Research Institute, including all furnishings, equipment, and
30	other chattels used in the operation of those facilities, with
31	a Florida not-for-profit corporation organized solely for the
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1 purpose of governing and operating the Ronald Reagan Johnnie B. Byrd, Sr., Alzheimer's Center and Research Institute. This 2 not-for-profit corporation, acting as an instrumentality of 3 4 the state, shall govern and operate the Ronald Reagan Johnnie B. Byrd, Sr., Alzheimer's Center and Research Institute in 5 accordance with the terms of the agreement between the State 6 7 Board of Education and the not-for-profit corporation. The not-for-profit corporation may, with the prior approval of the 8 State Board of Education, create either for-profit or 9 10 not-for-profit corporate subsidiaries, or both, to fulfill its 11 mission. The not-for-profit corporation and its subsidiaries are authorized to receive, hold, invest, and administer 12 13 property and any moneys acquired from private, local, state, and federal sources, as well as technical and professional 14 15 income generated or derived from practice activities of the 16 institute, for the benefit of the institute and the fulfillment of its mission. 17 (b)1. The affairs of the not-for-profit corporation 18 19 shall be managed by a board of directors who shall serve 20 without compensation. The board of directors shall consist of the President of the University of South Florida and the chair 21 22 of the State Board of Education, or their designees, 5 representatives of the state universities, and no fewer than 9 23 2.4 nor more than 14 representatives of the public who are neither medical doctors nor state employees. Each director who is a 25 representative of a state university or of the public shall be 26 appointed to serve a term of 3 years. The chair of the board 27 of directors shall be selected by a majority vote of the 28 29 directors. Each director shall have only one vote.

25	the not-for-profit corporation and its subsidiaries for
26	research, education, treatment, prevention, and the early
27	detection of Alzheimer's disease and for mutually approved
28	teaching and research programs conducted by the University of
29	South Florida or other accredited medical schools or research
30	institutes.
31	(d) Preparation of an annual financial audit pursuant
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1 to s. 11.45 of the not-for-profit corporation's accounts and the accounts of any subsidiaries to be conducted by an 2 independent certified public accountant. The annual audit 3 4 report shall include management letters and shall be submitted to the Auditor General and the State Board of Education for 5 review. The State Board of Education, the Auditor General, and 6 7 the Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability shall have the authority to require and receive 8 from the not-for-profit corporation and any subsidiaries, or 9 10 from their independent auditor, any detail or supplemental 11 data relative to the operation of the not-for-profit corporation or subsidiary. 12 (e) Provision by the not-for-profit corporation and 13 its subsidiaries of equal employment opportunities for all 14 15 persons regardless of race, color, religion, gender, age, or 16 national origin. (4) The State Board of Education is authorized to 17 18 secure comprehensive general liability protection, including 19 professional liability protection, for the not-for-profit 20 corporation and its subsidiaries, pursuant to s. 1004.24. The not-for-profit corporation and its subsidiaries shall be 21 22 exempt from any participation in any property insurance trust 23 fund established by law, including any property insurance 24 trust fund established pursuant to chapter 284, so long as the not-for-profit corporation and its subsidiaries maintain 25 property insurance protection with comparable or greater 26 coverage limits. 27 28 (5) In the event that the agreement between the 29 not-for-profit corporation and the State Board of Education is terminated for any reason, the State Board of Education shall 30 31 assume governance and operation of the facilities. 10:46 AM 03/29/05 s1872c-hell-c6g

13	discovered during the course of research conducted by or
14	through the institute and business transactions resulting from
15	such research;
16	(d) The identity of a donor or prospective donor to
17	the <u>Ronald Reagan</u> Johnnie B. Byrd, Sr., Alzheimer's Center and
18	Research Institute who wishes to remain anonymous, and all
19	information identifying such donor or prospective donor;
20	(e) Any information received by the institute in the
21	performance of its duties and responsibilities which is
22	otherwise confidential and exempt by law; and
23	(f) Any information received by the institute from a
24	person from another state or nation or the Federal Government
25	which is otherwise confidential or exempt pursuant to that
26	state's or nation's laws or pursuant to federal law.
27	
28	Any governmental entity that demonstrates a need to access
29	such confidential and exempt information in order to perform
30	its duties and responsibilities shall have access to such
31	information and shall otherwise keep such information
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1	confidential and exempt. This section is subject to the Open
2	Government Sunset Review Act of 1995 in accordance with s.
3	119.15 and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2006, unless
4	reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the
5	Legislature.
б	(10) Any appropriation to the institute provided in a
7	general appropriations act shall be paid directly to the board
8	of directors of the not-for-profit corporation by warrant
9	drawn by the Chief Financial Officer from the State Treasury.
