The Committee on Criminal Justice (Haridopolos) recommended the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 2, between lines 7 and 8,

insert:

Section 2. It is the intent of the Legislature that the normal costs attributable to the 2005 actuarial study of a law enforcement and correctional officer training service upgrade shall be funded by recognition of a lump sum of \$1.67 million from the excess actuarial assets of the Florida Retirement System Trust Fund.

Section 3. The Legislature finds that a proper and legitimate state purpose is served when employees and retirees of the state and of its political subdivisions, and the dependents, survivors, and beneficiaries of such employees and retirees, are extended the basic protections afforded by governmental retirement systems that provide fair and adequate benefits that are managed, administered, and funded in an actuarially sound manner, as required by section 14, Article X
