27	disregarded if known.
28	Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2014.
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********** SENATE SUMMARY Provides that it is a conflict of interest for a member of the Legislature to receive compensation from an agency or business entity receiving state moneys unless the member receives such compensation for services in his or her regular profession or occupation and his or her selection to perform the services is accomplished in ignorance of, or without regard to, the member's status.
