97 must successfully complete training in the identification and 98 investigation of elder abuse and neglect as a part of the 99 officer's basic recruit training required in s. 943.13(9) or 100 continuing training or education required under s. 943.135(1) 101 before June 30, 2008. The training shall be developed in 102 consultation with the Department of Elderly Affairs and must 103 incorporate instruction on identification of and appropriate 104 responses to persons suffering from dementia and on the 105 identification and investigation of elder abuse and neglect. If 106 an officer fails to meet the training requirements, his or her 107 certification shall become inactive until the employing agency 108 notifies the commission that the officer has completed the 109 training. 110 Section 4.
