(7) A person who alters the petition or petition  
revocation form signed by any other person without the other  
person's knowledge and consent commits a misdemeanor of the  
first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s.  
775.083 and, upon any subsequent conviction, commits a felony  
of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s.  
775.083, or s. 775.084.

(8) A person perpetrating, or attempting to perpetrate  
or aid in the perpetration of, any fraud in connection with  
obtaining the signature of electors on petition or petition  
revocation forms commits a misdemeanor of the first degree,  
punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083 and, upon  
any subsequent conviction, commits a felony of the third  
degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or

2       (9) In addition to any other penalty provided for by  
3 law, if a paid petition circulator, as defined in s.  
4 100.372(1), violates any provision of this section, the  
5 commission may, pursuant to s. 106.265, impose a civil penalty  
6 in the form of a fine not to exceed \$1,000 per violation on  
7 such paid petition circulator.
