Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 1, lines 21-31, delete those lines

and insert:

(d) The employing agency of a law enforcement officer as defined in s. 943.10 is not liable for injury, death, or property damage effected or caused by a person fleeing from a law enforcement officer in a motor vehicle if:

1. At the time the law enforcement officer initiates the pursuit, the officer reasonably believes that the person fleeing has committed a forcible felony violation as defined in s. 776.08; and

2. The pursuit is conducted by the officer pursuant to a written high-speed pursuit policy adopted by the employing agency. The policy must contain specific procedures on the proper method to initiate and terminate high-speed pursuit. The law enforcement officer must have received instructional training from the employing agency on the written high-speed
