Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 2024

A concurrent resolution providing that Joint
Rule 1 of the Joint Rules of the Legislature,
relating to legislative lobbying, is superseded
by the provisions of Committee Substitute for
Senate Bill 2646 to the extent that such Joint
Rule conflicts with or is inconsistent with the
provisions of Committee Substitute for Senate
Bill 2646, as enacted by the Legislature;
authorizing technical and stylistic changes to
conform the Joint Rules of the Legislature;
providing for publication in the journals of
the respective houses of the Legislature.

Be It Resolved by the Senate of the State of Florida, the House of Representatives Concurring:

That, effective January 1, 2006, Joint Rule 1 of the Joint Rules of the Legislature, relating to legislative lobbyist registration and reporting, is superseded by and amended to conform to the provisions of Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 2646 to the extent that such Joint Rule conflicts with or is inconsistent with Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 2646, as enacted by the Legislature. Joint Rule 1, as created herein, shall remain in effect until amended by the Legislature.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House of Representatives are authorized and directed to make technical and stylistic changes to conform the Joint Rules of the Legislature to the provisions of this Concurrent Resolution and to publish the same in the
