Senate Amendment

On page 8, line 5, after the period,

insert: Notwithstanding the provisions of this subsection,
the commission may arbitrate, enforce, or approve
interconnection agreements, and resolve disputes, as provided
by 47 U.S.C. ss. 251 and 252, or any other applicable federal
or state law or regulation. The duties of a local exchange
telecommunications company to provide unbundled network
elements, interconnection, collocation arrangements, or any
other service, right, or benefit to any party, regardless of
the technology, are those that the company is obligated to
extend or provide under applicable federal or state law and
regulations.
