**Senate Amendment**

On page 6, line 21, through  
page 7, line 27, delete those lines

and insert:

(j) The types of books and records kept in the regular course of business which must be available during an audit of a dealer's books and records when the dealer has made an allocation or attribution pursuant to the definition of sales prices in s. 202.11(14)(b)8. and examples of methods for determining the reasonableness thereof. Books and records kept in the regular course of business include, but are not limited to, general ledgers, price lists, cost records, customer billings, billing system reports, tariffs, and other regulatory filings and rules of regulatory authorities. Such records may be required to be made available to the department in an electronic format when so kept by the dealer. The dealer may support the allocation of charges with books and records

2 entire service area, including territories outside this state.  
3 During an audit, the department may reasonably require  
4 production of any additional books and records found necessary
