



1           Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005,  
2 only if enacted by a three-fifths vote of the membership of  
3 each house of the Legislature and only if SB 1938 or similar  
4 legislation is enacted during the same legislative session or  
5 an extension thereof and becomes law.

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7                   STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN  
8                   COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR  
9                   Senate Bill 2078

10 The committee substitute differs from the bill in that it:

- 11 - Provides that the trust fund is administered by OTTED;
- 12 - Provides that the purpose of the trust fund is to fund  
13 the Florida Aerospace Infrastructure Program, whose  
14 primary goal is to support the growth of the aerospace  
15 industry;
- 16 - Authorizes DOR to distribute sales taxes from General  
17 Revenue to the trust fund;
- 18 - References those sales taxes that will fund the trust  
19 fund instead of explicitly stating them in the bill; and
- 20 - Removes language requiring each dealer to file monthly  
21 returns to DOR with segregated tax information (this  
22 provision is transferred to SB 1938).
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
