A bill to be entitled

An act relating to community redevelopment agencies' expenses for fire services; amending s. 163.356, F.S.; authorizing a county or a municipality to appropriate funds for the expenses of a community redevelopment agency for fire rescue services; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (d) of subsection (3) of section 163.356, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

163.356 Creation of community redevelopment agency.--
(3)

(d) ~~At~~ Any time after the creation of a community redevelopment agency, the governing body of the county or municipality may appropriate to the agency such amounts as the governing body deems necessary for the administrative expenses and overhead of the agency, including the development and implementation of community policing innovations and including enhanced or innovative fire rescue services.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2005.

SENATE SUMMARY

Authorizes a local government to appropriate funds for the expenses of a community redevelopment agency for fire rescue services.
