A bill to be entitled
An act relating to a special election to be held on September 6, 2005, pursuant to Section 5 of Article XI of the State Constitution, for the approval or rejection by the electors of this state of a joint resolution amending Section 1 of Article IX of the State Constitution, relating to provisions that mandate maximum class sizes for students in prekindergarten through grade 12; providing a contingent effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 5 of Article XI of the State Constitution, there shall be a special election on September 6, 2005, at which there shall be submitted to the electors of this state for approval or rejection Senate Joint Resolution No. , proposing an amendment to Section 1 of Article XI of the State Constitution, relating to provisions that prescribe the maximum class sizes allowed for students in prekindergarten through grade 12.

Section 2. Publication of notice shall be in accordance with Section 5 of Article XI of the State Constitution. The special election shall be held in the same manner as other special elections are held.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, if enacted by the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the membership of each house of the Legislature.
