32 (b) "Defibrillation" means the administration of a 33 <u>controlled electrical charge to the heart to restore a viable</u> 34 cardiac rhythm.

(2) In order to ensure public health and safety:

36 <u>(a)(1)</u> All persons who use an automated external 37 defibrillator must obtain appropriate training, to include 38 completion of a course in cardiopulmonary resuscitation or 39 successful completion of a basic first aid course that includes 40 cardiopulmonary resuscitation training, and demonstrated 41 proficiency in the use of an automated external defibrillator;

42 (b)(2) Any person or entity in possession of an automated 43 external defibrillator is encouraged to register with the local 44 emergency medical services medical director the existence and 45 location of the automated external defibrillator; and

46 <u>(c)</u>(3) Any person who uses an automated external 47 defibrillator <u>shall</u> is required to activate the emergency 48 medical services system as soon as possible upon use of the 49 automated external defibrillator.
