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The Committee on Transportation (Klein) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 3, between lines 8 and 9,

insert:

(4) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, in order to protect marina property, a marina owner by contract may provide that if a boat owner fails to promptly remove a vessel from a marina after issuance of a hurricane watch or warning, the marina owner, operator, or an employee or agent of the owner or operator may remove the vessel from its slip or take whatever actions are deemed necessary in order to properly secure the vessel. A marina owner, operator, employee, or agent may charge the boat owner a reasonable fee for any such services rendered. Any marina seeking to add such a provision to a contract must provide notice to the boat owner in any such contract in a font of at least 10-point type. The notice shall be in substantially the following form:

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NOTICE TO BOAT OWNER

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The undersigned hereby informs you that in the event you fail to remove your vessel from the marina promptly after the issuance of a hurricane watch or warning for _____, Florida, under Florida law the undersigned or his or her employees or agents are authorized to remove your vessel from its slip or take any and all other actions deemed appropriate by the undersigned or his or her employees or agents in order to secure your vessel and protect marina property. You are further notified that you may be charged a reasonable fee for any such action.
