and insert:

Section 2. Subsection (8) of section 316.614, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

316.614 Safety belt usage.--

(8) Any person who violates the provisions of this section commits a nonmoving violation, punishable as provided in chapter 318. By January 1, 2006, each law enforcement agency in this state shall adopt departmental policy to prohibit the practice of racial profiling. When a law enforcement officer issues a citation for a violation of this section, the law enforcement officer must record the race and ethnicity of the violator. All law enforcement agencies must maintain such information and forward the information to the department in a form and manner determined by the department. The department shall collect this information by jurisdiction

1 and annually report the data to the Governor, the President of
 2 the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
 3 The report must show separate statewide totals for the state's
 4 county sheriffs and municipal law enforcement agencies, state
 5 law enforcement agencies, and state university law enforcement
 6 agencies. However, except for violations of s. 316.613,
 7 enforcement of this section by state or local law enforcement
 8 agencies must be accomplished only as a secondary action when
 9 a driver of a motor vehicle has been detained for a suspected
 10 violation of another section of this chapter, chapter 320, or
 11 chapter 322.
