**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 84, between lines 14 and 15,

insert:

Section 52. Subsection (4) of section 322.142, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

322.142 Color photographic or digital imaged licenses.--

(4) The department may maintain a film negative or print file. The department shall maintain a record of the digital image and signature of the licensees, together with other data required by the department for identification and retrieval. Reproductions from the file or digital record shall be made and issued only for departmental administrative purposes; for the issuance of duplicate licenses; in response to law enforcement agency requests; to the Department of State pursuant to an interagency agreement to facilitate determinations of eligibility of voter registration applicants and registered voters in accordance with ss. 98.045 and

 2 interagency agreement to facilitate service of process in  
 3 Title IV-D cases; or to the Department of Financial Services

 6 unclaimed property claims, and the identification of  
 7 fraudulent or false claims, and are exempt from the provisions
