Enterprise zone designation for Orange 15 County and the City of Orlando and Osceola County and the City 16 of Kissimmee. -- Orange County and the City of Orlando and Osceola County and the City of Kissimmee may jointly apply to 18 the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development for 19 designation of two enterprise zones encompassing areas that 2.0 21 include the boundaries of the community redevelopment zone 22 established under part III of chapter 163, Florida Statutes. 23 The application must be submitted by December 31, 2005, and must comply with the requirements of section 290.0055, Florida 2.4 Statutes. Notwithstanding section 290.0065, Florida Statutes, 2.5 which limits the total number of enterprise zones designated 26 27 and the number of enterprise zones within a population 2.8 category, the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development may designate one enterprise zone under this 29 section.
