On page 14, between lines 9 and 10,

insert:

Section 9. Subsection (8) is added to section 1011.68, Florida Statutes, to read:

1011.68 Funds for student transportation.--The annual allocation to each district for transportation to public school programs, including charter schools as provided in s. 1002.33(17)(b), of students in membership in kindergarten through grade 12 and in migrant and exceptional student programs below kindergarten shall be determined as follows:

(8) Notwithstanding s. 1006.22(1) and (2), if an isolated student attends a charter school governed by a community college, the community college shall generate school transportation funding according to ss. 1002.33(17)(b), 1011.62, and this section. A community college board of trustees may include in its charter school contract a provision for parent transportation of students which is
