A bill to be entitled
An act relating to emergency medical services;
creating s. 401.49, F.S.; providing that
chapter 401, F.S., supersedes earlier local
acts on the subject of medical transport unless
those local acts are reenacted by the
Legislature; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 401.49, Florida Statutes, is
created to read:

401.49 Certificate of public convenience and
necessity; advanced life support emergency medical services
license.--This chapter supersedes any special act relating to
medical transport enacted before July 1, 2005, unless that
special act is reenacted by the Legislature.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.

SENATE SUMMARY

Provides that general law on the subject of medical
transport supersedes earlier special acts. Special acts
must be reenacted by the Legislature in order to have
effect.
