8	WHEREAS, stem cells are cells that have the remarkable
9	potential to develop into many different cell types in the
10	body, theoretically dividing without limit to replenish other
11	cells for as long as the person or animal is alive, and
12	WHEREAS, when a stem cell divides, each daughter cell
13	has the potential to either remain a stem cell or become
14	another type of cell with a more specialized function, such as
15	a muscle cell, a red blood cell, or a brain cell, NOW,
16	THEREFORE,

18	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
19	
20	Section 1. There is hereby established a state stem
21	cell research program. The program shall use the ethical
22	quidelines published by the National Institutes of Health,
23	requiring that all cell lines be derived from the six existing
24	stem cell line embryos that were originally created for
25	<u>fertility treatments.</u>
26	Section 2. The sum of \$10 million is appropriated from
27	the General Revenue Fund to the stem cell research program.
28	Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
