 2 An act relating to law enforcement, correctional, and
 3 correctional probation officers; amending s. 110.219,
 4 F.S.; providing for a payout of a limited amount of
 5 accumulated annual leave in certain circumstances;
 6 providing an effective date.

 8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 10 Section 1. Subsection (8) is added to section 110.219,
 11 Florida Statutes, to read:

12 110.219 Attendance and leave; general policies.--

13 (8) Notwithstanding subsection (7) and s. 110.2037, each
 14 December a law enforcement officer, correctional officer, or
 15 correctional probation officer with at least 20 years of full-
 16 time service with the state shall be entitled to a payout of up
 17 to 48 hours of annual leave subject to the following conditions:

18 (a) The employee must have an annual leave balance of no
 19 less than 240 hours after the payout in order to qualify for
 20 this benefit.

21 (b) The payout must be deposited in a tax-sheltered plan
 22 under s. 401(a) of the Internal Revenue Code, as provided for in
 23 s. 110.2037.

 25 This payout shall be in addition to any payout provided for in
 26 subsection (7).

27 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
