86 cents in federal transportation funding for each dollar in transportation taxes and fees contributed, NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida: That the President and the Congress of the United States are requested to expedite reauthorization of the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century to guarantee Florida and the other 49 states at least a 95-percent rate of return on all federal transportation funds distributed. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be dispatched to the President of the United States, to the President of the United States Senate, to the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, and to each member of the Florida delegation to the United States Congress.
