827.01 Definitions.--As used in this chapter: (1) "Caregiver" means a parent, adult household member, law enforcement officer or employee of a municipal or county detention facility or of the Department of Corrections while acting in an official capacity, public school volunteer, б religious organization volunteer, health care provider, or other person responsible for a child's welfare. Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. SENATE SUMMARY Defines the terms "other person responsible for a child's welfare" and "caregiver" to include a law enforcement officer, public school volunteer, a religious organization volunteer, a health care provider for purposes of ch. 39, Florida Statutes. 2.4
